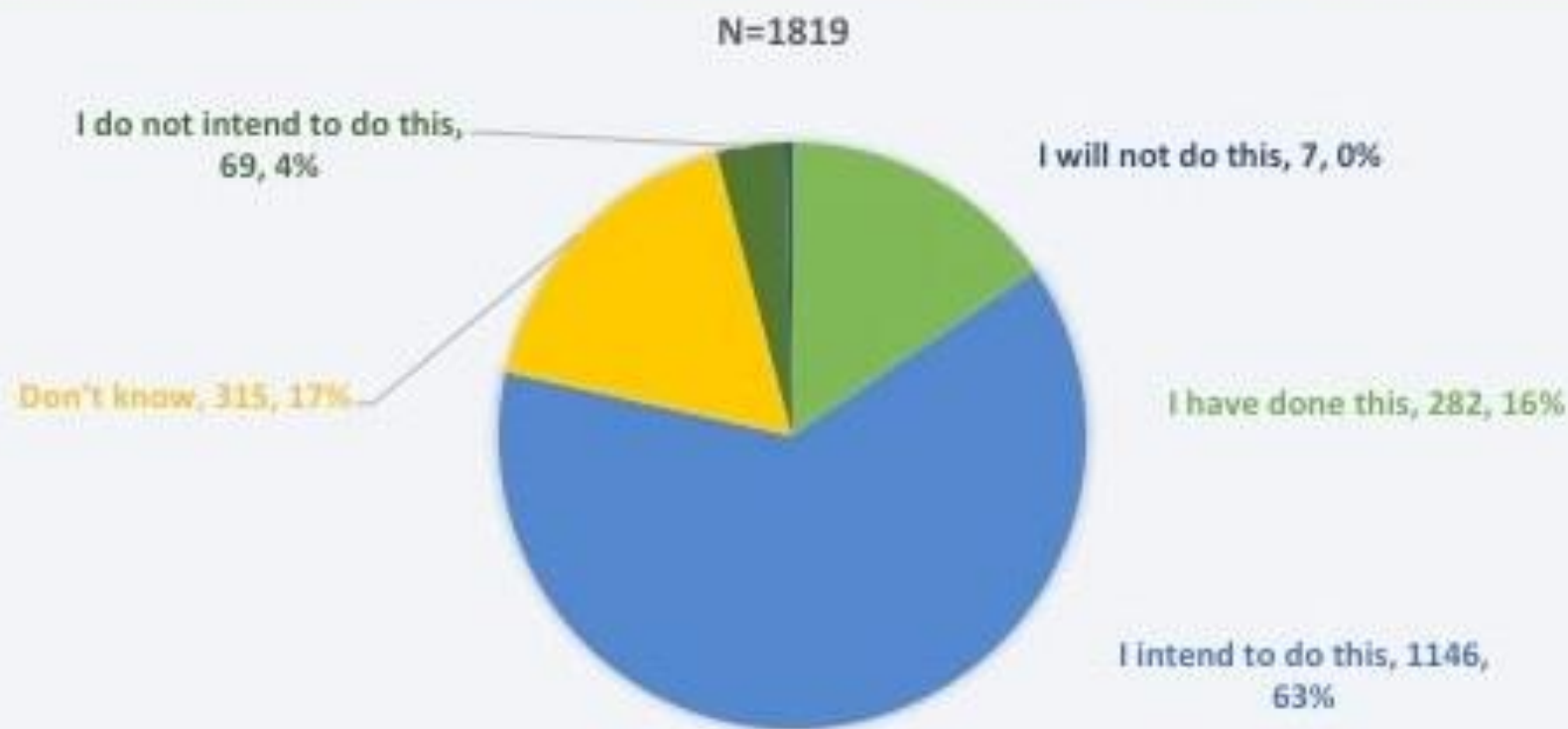

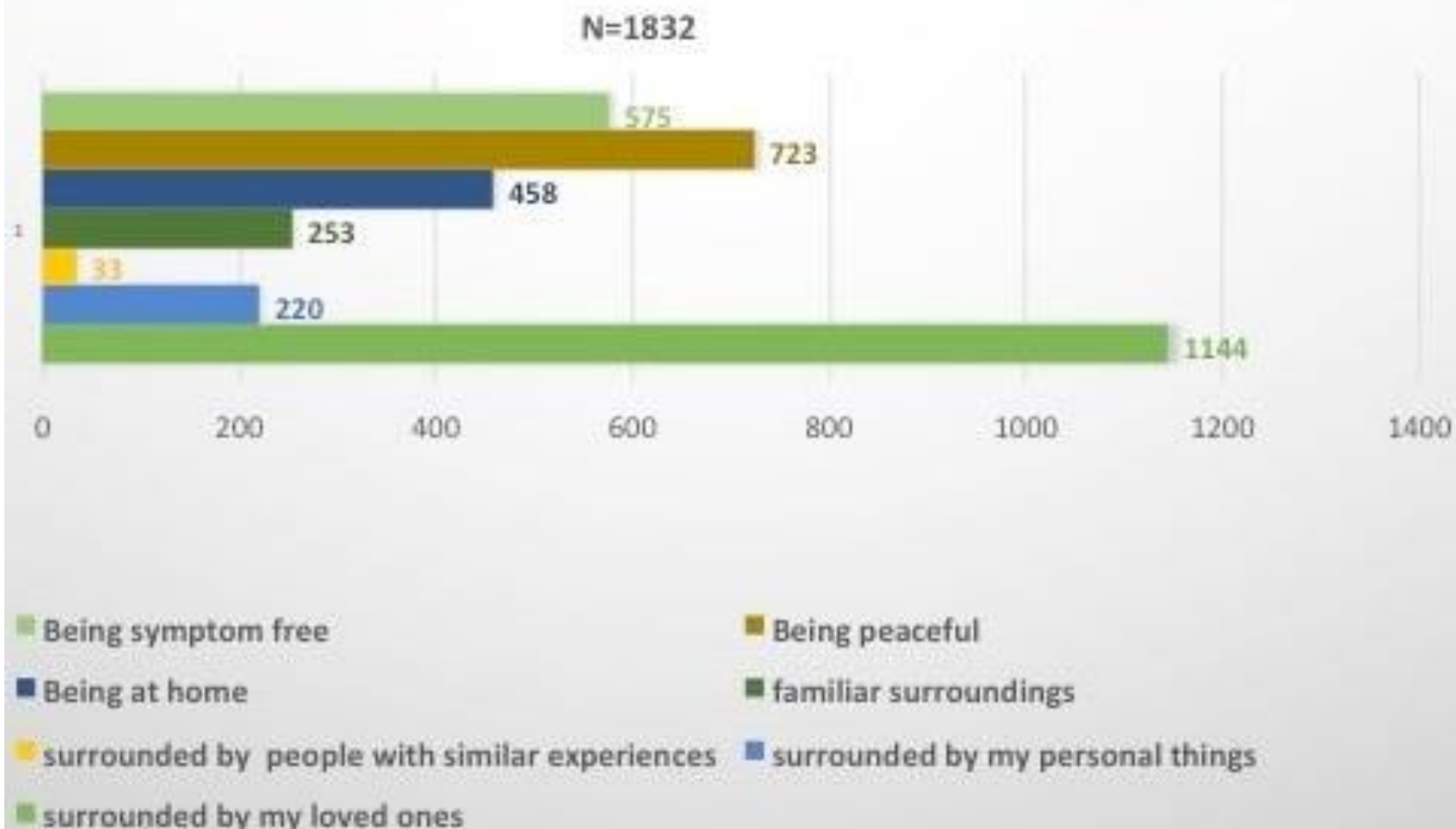

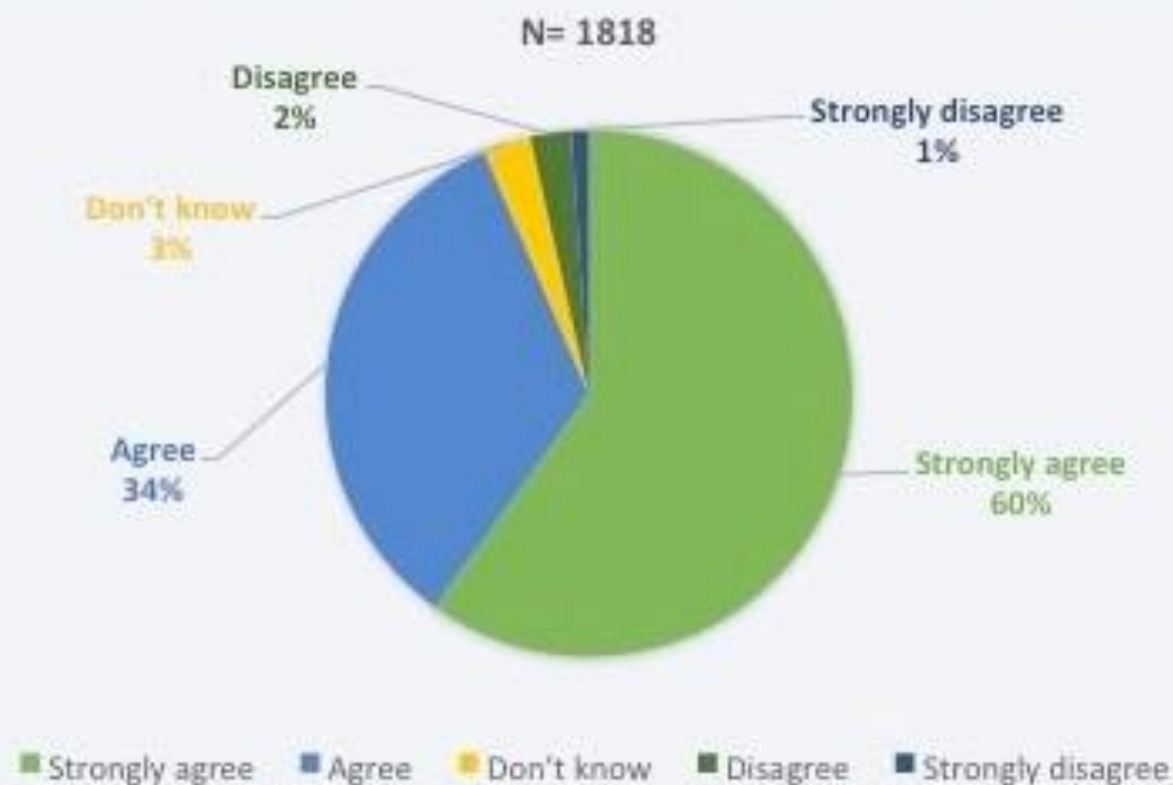

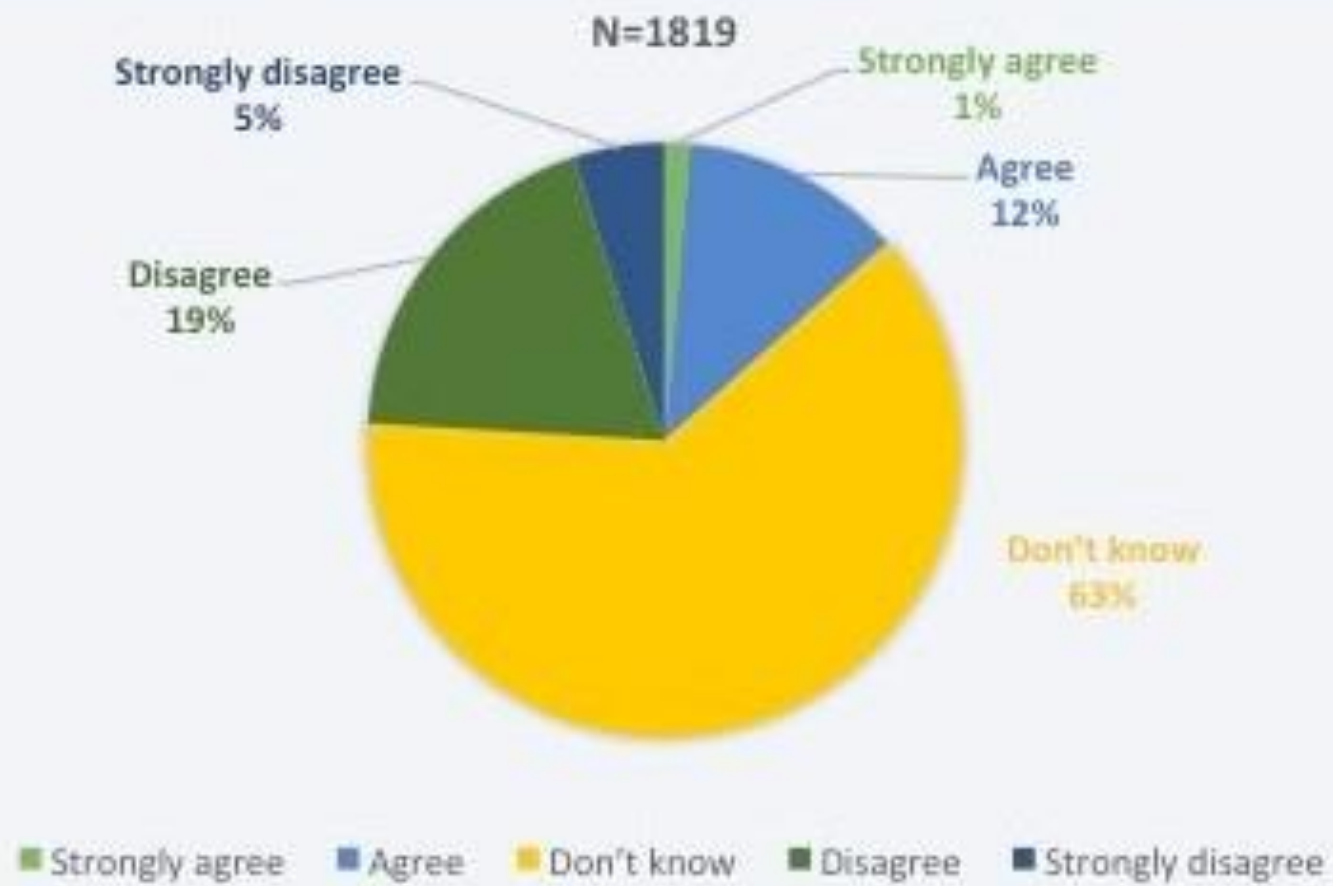
WHAT KIND OF ENVIRONMENT DO PATIENTS PREFER AT THE END OF LIFE?



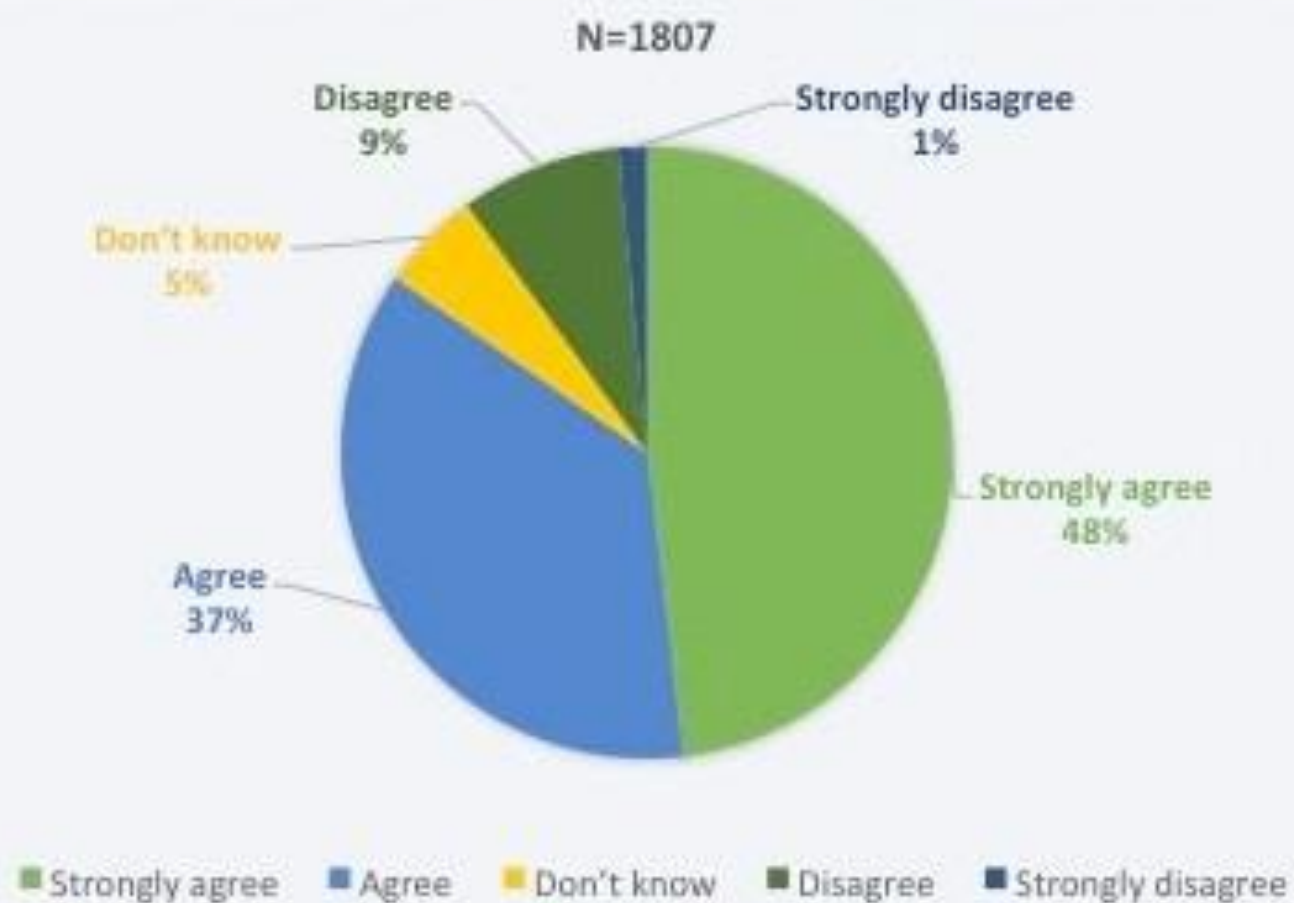

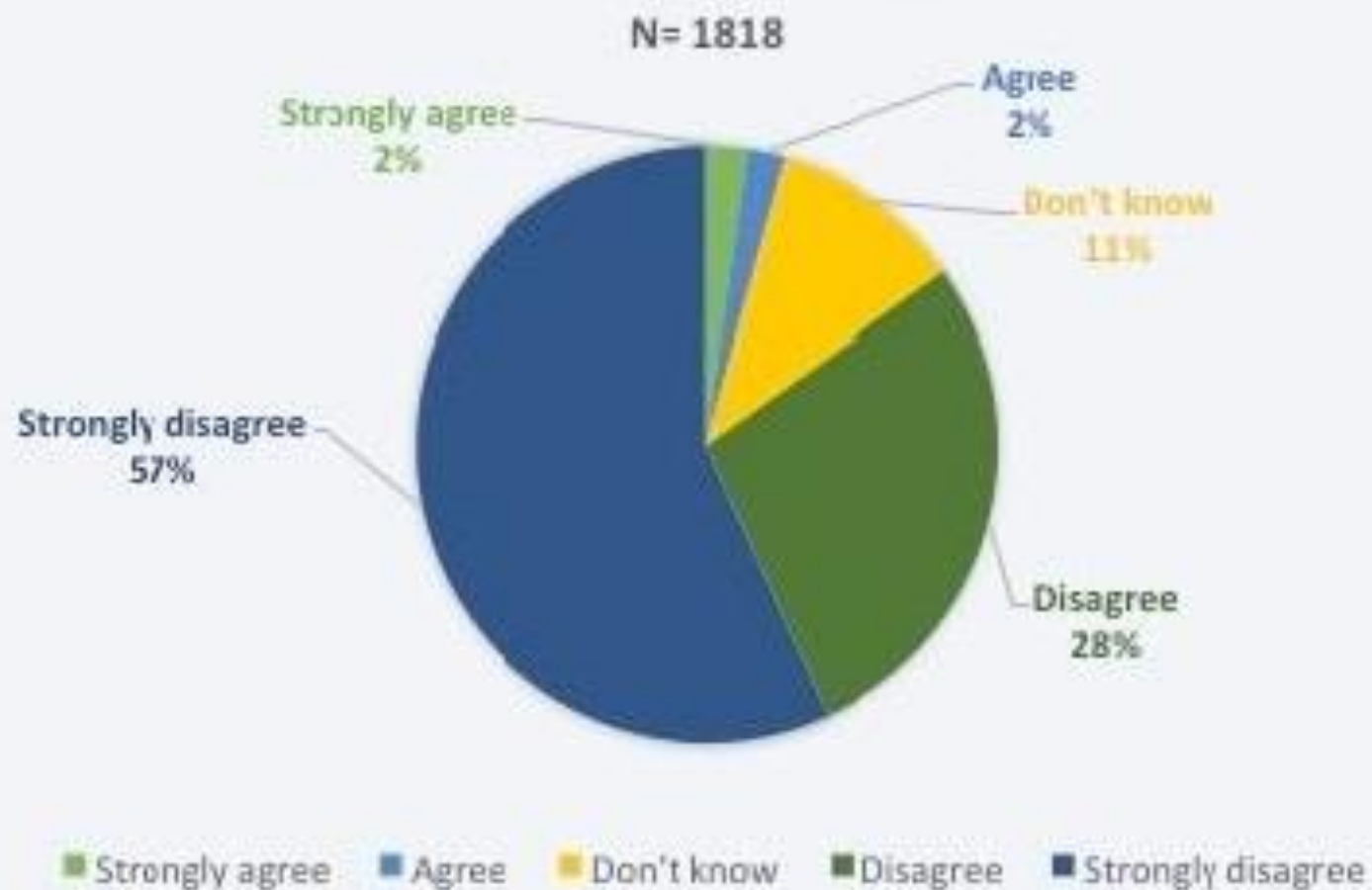
VIEWS ON END OF LIFE CARE: CULTURAL NEEDS ARE BEING MET
